Jason Wierzbanowski is the Vice President of Contrails Independent Consulting, LLC, and is currently under contract with the Operations Directorate at the Air Force Research Laboratory.

Jason directly supports numerous manned and un-manned flight test programs where his expertise is leveraged in the planning and execution of a diverse portfolio of systems under test.

Prior to this position, Jason was an active duty Air Force Officer, retiring at the rank of Lieutenant Colonel.

After graduating from the Air Force Academy in 1995, he went to pilot training and was subsequently selected for the B-1 as his operational weapon system.

After graduating from the USAF Test Pilot School, he led developmental flight test in the B-1 and eventually became the 419th Flight Test Squadron Commander and Global Power Bomber Combined Test Force Director.

In this capacity he led a 500+ person team in developmental flight test for the B-1, B-2 and B-52 Bombers.

During his flying career, Jason accumulated over 3500 hours in 27 different aircraft ranging from the T-37 trainer to the B-2 bomber.
